

## Broadway Article Reaction Paper

This assignment is worth 10 points. This is how you make up participation credit for days you were absent.

You will select an article of your choosing to read. The article you select *should be* from THEATRICAL sources and should be “feature” articles. In other words, **do not** use articles about movies or TV shows. The articles should be about something, **not** a review of a play, or announcing upcoming dates for a play.

Please attach each article (or a copy of it, or email me a copy) to your reaction paper. Each reaction paper should contain a brief SUMMARY of the article (3-5 sentences in one paragraph) and a REACTION to the article (4-6 sentences in one paragraph). The reaction should tell me your thoughts about the article and how it relates to you and what it further reveals about the play you researched. What did you learn? How does it pertain to students of the theatre?
